GENERAL NOTES - ALL PROJECTS:

1. Submission of sealed bids and proposal conferences, will remain at the Department of Public Works.

2. Dates for all Projects are subject to change. Notification by addenda will be provided in the event these dates change.

3. The Mandatory requirements for the Proposer includes:

- Knowledge and experience in the design of roadways and bridges consistent with the policies of the DPW, FHWA and AASHTO standards and design guidelines.
- Prior experience in performing bridge inspections complying with 23 CFR 650, Subpart C, including the performance of Level I and Level II underwater inspections.
- Be financially stable.
- Have a local business license.
- Have a current Certificate of Authorization approved by the PEALS Board.
- Have personnel who meet the qualification requirements of 23 CFR 650.309.
- Be properly insured for the work to be performed.
