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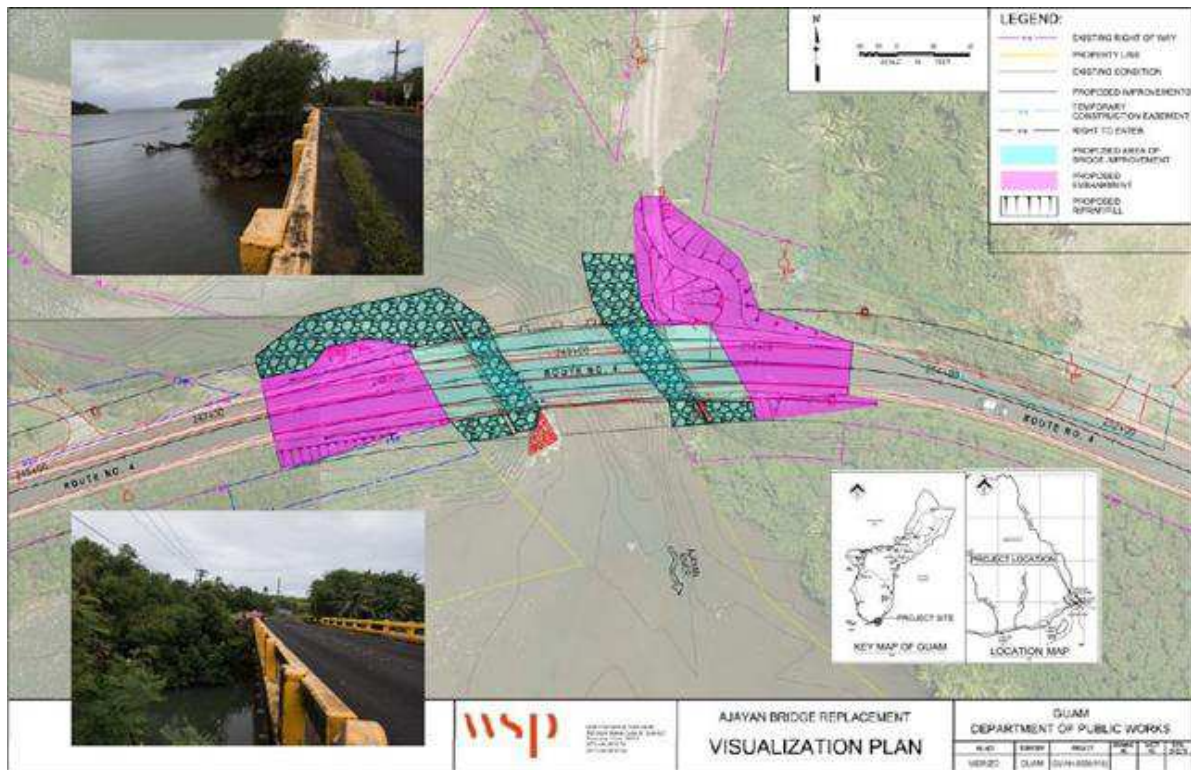

(Tamuning - Wednesday, August 15, 2018) The Department of Public Works (DPW) would like to remind the public that from Thursday, August 16, 2018 through Sunday, August 19, 2018, the Route 1 southbound left lane from the Dededo Precinct to the Route 3 intersection will be closed. Two through lanes will be maintained. Motorists traveling southbound on Route 1 are advised to merge to the right in advance of the construction zone.

Motorists are advised to drive cautiously through all construction zones, observe all posted speed limit and construction signs, and carefully heed to flaggers. Alternative routes and/or adjusting drive times when feasible are encouraged.

ROUTE 14 RESURFACING **(ROUTE 1 TO ARCHBISHOP FLORES CIRCLE)** **PROJECT NO. GU-NH-0014(002)**

NOTES:

1. Sealed bids should be submitted in duplicate at the 2nd Floor, Division of Highways Building Room 201, Department of Public Works, 542 North Marine Corps Drive, Tamuning, Guam 96913, no later than 2:00 P.M., on the date specified above. At this time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud to the public.

2. Contract time is per the calendar days after the issuance of Notice to Proceed as specified above. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of 15% of the total bid amount. Accepted form of bid security may be bid bond, certified check or cashier's check payable to the Treasurer of Guam.

3. Bid documents can be obtained at no cost at the 2nd Floor, Division of Highways Building Room 201, Department of Public Works, 542 North Marine Corps Drive, Tamuning, Guam 96913. All bidders who secured the corresponding bid documents will be officially listed in the Government's Distribution Record as prospective bidders for these construction projects. At the DPW's discretion, the DPW may provide the documentation electronically via CD. Log onto the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) website at fh.fhwa.dot.gov/resources/specs/fp-03/ to obtain a copy of the "Standard Specifications for Construction of Roads and Bridges on Federal Highway Projects FP-03". 4. The sureties of all bonds must be on the approved listing by the the United States Department of Treasury listed as "Companies Holding Certificates of Authority as Acceptable Sureties on Federal Bonds and Acceptable Reassuring Companies". The penal amount of the bond shall not exceed the surety's underwriting limit as stated in the Department of Treasury

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listing. A notarized true copy of Certificate of Authority is also required.

All prospective bidders are encouraged to attend. Items discussed during pre-bid conferences will be made part of the contract document.

(Tamuning - Sunday, August 19, 2018) The Department of Public Works (DPW) would like to remind the public that starting Monday, August 20, 2018 through 4:00 PM on Wednesday, August 22, 2018, the Route 1 southbound left lane from the Dededo Precinct through the construction zone will be closed. Two through lanes will be maintained. Motorists traveling southbound on Route 1 are advised to merge to the right in advance of the construction zone.

Motorists are advised to drive cautiously through all construction zones, observe all posted speed limit and construction signs, and carefully heed to flaggers. Alternative routes and/or adjusting drive times when feasible are encouraged.

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SPECIAL TRAFFIC ADVISORY: Route 1/3 Intersection and Route 3 Widening

Route 1/3 Intersection Improvements

From Saturday, August 25, 2018 at 4:00 AM to Sunday, August 26, 2018 at 5:00 PM the Route 1 southbound and northbound lanes within the project will be reduced to one through lane only due to paving work.

The southbound lanes will be reduced to one lane starting before the Route 27A (Fatima Road) intersection to Route 3 intersection. On Saturday, motorists are advised to merge right before the Route 27A intersection. On Sunday, motorists are advised to merge left before the Route 27A intersection. Trucks and other large vehicles are advised to detour using Route 27 or Route 27A.

The Route 1 northbound will be reduced to one through lane and one right turn lane west of the Route 16 (Micronesia Mall) intersection. The center lane will be closed. U-turn and through traffic are advised to merge left. The right lane will be restricted to right turn only at Route 16.

Route 3 Widening

On Saturday, August 25, 2018, the inner southbound lane on Route 3 just south of the Route 28 intersection will be closed from 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Motorists are advised to drive cautiously through the construction zones, observe all posted speed limits and construction signs, and expect delays. Adjusting drive times when feasible are encouraged.

Motorists are advised to heed flaggers, follow alternate signs, drive cautiously through the construction zones, observe all posted speed limits and construction signs, and expect longer delays. Adjusting drive times when feasible are encouraged.

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**REMINDER: Rte 1 Near 1/3
Intersection Reduced to 1
Northbound and 1 Southbound
Lane**

(Tamuning - Saturday, August 25, 2018) The Department of Public Works (DPW) would like to remind the public that on Sunday, August 26, 2018, the Route 1 southbound and northbound lanes will be reduced to one through lane only around the Route 1/Route 3 Intersection due to paving work.

The southbound lanes will be reduced to one lane from Route 27A (Fatima Road) to Route 3 intersection from 4:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Motorists are advised to **merge left** before the Route 27A intersection. Trucks and other large vehicles are advised to detour using Route 27 or Route 27A.

The Route 1 northbound will be reduced to one through lane and one right turn lane west of the Route 16 (Micronesia Mall) intersection. The center lane will be closed. U-turn and through traffic are advised to merge left. The right lane will be restricted to right turn only at Route 16.

Motorists are advised to heed flaggers, follow alternate signs, drive cautiously through the construction zones, observe all posted speed limits and construction signs, and expect longer delays. Adjusting drive times when feasible are encouraged.

Route 1/3 Intersection Improvements

On Saturday, September 1, 2018, the Route 1 southbound and northbound lanes will be reduced to one through lane only due to paving work.

The southbound lanes will be reduced to one through lane starting before the Route 27A (Fatima Road) intersection to Micronesia Mall from 4:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Motorists are advised to merge right before the Route 27A intersection.

The Route 1 northbound will be reduced to one through lane and one right turn lane west of the Route 16 (Micronesia Mall) intersection. The center lane will be closed. U-turn and through traffic are advised to merge left. The right lane will be restricted to right turn only at Route 16.

Motorists are advised to heed flaggers, follow alternate route signs, drive cautiously through the construction zones, observe all posted speed limits and construction signs, and expect longer delays. Adjusting drive times when feasible are encouraged.

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
