The sureties of all bonds must be on the approved listing by the the United States Department of Treasury listed as "Companies Holding Certificates of Authority as Acceptable Sureties on Federal Bonds and Acceptable Reassuring Companies". The penal amount of the bond shall not exceed the surety's underwriting limit as stated in the Department of Treasury listing. A notarized true copy of Certificate of Authority is also required.

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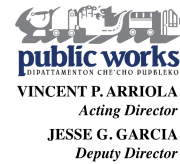

MEDIA Release DPW to Offer Geometric Design Course

(Tamuning, Guam, February 6, 2019) In response to a request from the engineering community to provide more capacity building opportunities for the industry, the Department of Public Works in partnership with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the National Highway Institute (NHI) will be hosting the first in a series of workshops with the goal to provide opportunities for technical advancement, innovative processes and procedures relative to the industry and best practices.

The first course will be held February 27-28. Details of the course are as follows:

Course: Geometric Design Course

Dates: February 27-28, 2019

Course Description: Improving the process of developing roadway geometry by applying flexibility and risk management in highway design. This approach to roadway design allows for a systematic process for making design decisions given specific project constraints and risks and is supported by FHWA. The training exercises and case studies provide practical applications of current knowledge from research and experience of safety and operational effects for various design elements.

Course Level: 380095

George Merritt is a Senior Safety and Geometric Design Engineer with FHWA's Resource Center. He is responsible for assisting the deployment of new technology for improving safety on our Nation's highways including: performance based practical design, innovative intersection design, data driven safety analysis, freeway/Interstate interchange design, nighttime visibility, roadway departure/roadside design, human factors applications, and AASHTO's Highway Safety Manual.

Course Instructors: **Richard "Dick" Albin Dick** joined FHWA as a Safety Engineer with the FHWA Resource Center's Safety and Design Team in June, 2008. Prior to joining FHWA, Dick worked for 15 years with the Washington State Department of Transportation and for 6 years for the New York State Department of Transportation in a Regional office. He graduated from the University of Wyoming with a BS in Civil Engineering and is a licensed Professional Engineer in Washington State. Dick chaired the TRB Roadside Safety Design Committee from 2009-2015 and is also a member of several NCHRP panels that oversee research on roadside safety issues.

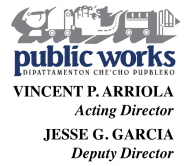

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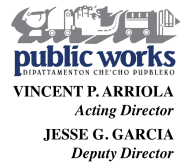
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REMINDER: Lane Closures and Shifts at Juan Jacinto Drive/Route 1 Intersection Today and Tomorrow

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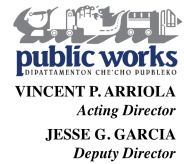

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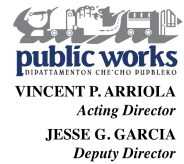
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Northbound Lane Closures on Route 1 Near Pigo Cemetery Due to Water Line Break

The DPW asks that drivers be cautious in the area and when possible to seek alternate routes.

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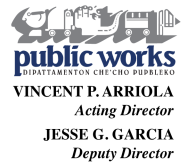
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UPDATE: Northbound Lane Closures on Route 1 Near Pigo Cemetery Due to Water Line Break

The DPW advises all to drive cautiously in the area and seek alternate routes.

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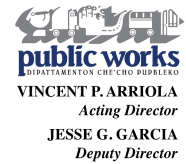

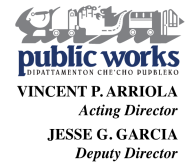

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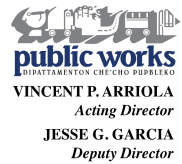
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Stay Safe During Typhoon Wutip
