(Tamuning, Guam, June 6, 2019) In an ongoing effort to provide more capacity building opportunities for the contractor industry, the Department of Public Works in partnership with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) will be hosting a Work Zone Training Workshop. The Workshop will be offered free to the contractor community, as well as various GovGuam Agencies (Utilities, Safety, Emergency). The Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) will be addressed for Guam's roadways.
