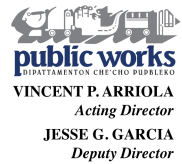

## **SPECIAL TRAFFIC ADVISORY: Route 1 / Route 8 Resurfacing and Route 8/Canada-Toto Loop Intersection (11/1/2019)**

### **Route 1 / Route 8 Resurfacing and Route 8/Canada-Toto Loop Intersection**

- On Saturday 11/2/2019, there will be intermittent lane closures and lane shifts at the intersection of Route 8 and Canada-Toto Loop Road from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
- On Sunday 11/3/2019, the DPW contractor will be milling and paving along the Route 8/10/16 Intersection and the Route 8A Intersection in Barrigada. Motorists are advised that there will be lane closures and lane shifts along the northbound, eastbound and westbound lanes from 6:00 AM to 5:00 PM. The traffic signals will not be operational during construction.

Motorists should proceed with caution and observe all posted speed limit and construction signs. Alternative routes and/or adjusting drive times when feasible are encouraged.

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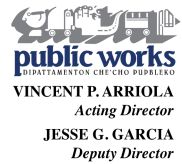

## **SPECIAL TRAFFIC ADVISORY: Route 1 / Route 8 Resurfacing and Route 8/Canada-Toto Loop Intersection (11/8/2019)**

### **Route 1 / Route 8 Resurfacing and Route 8/Canada-Toto Loop Intersection**

- On Saturday 11/9/2019, there will be intermittent lane closures and lane shifts at the intersection of Route 8 and Canada-Toto Loop Road from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
- On Saturday 11/9/2019, the Department of Public Works' contractor will be milling and paving at the southeast corner of the Route 8/10/16 Intersection (by 76 gas station) in Barrigada. Motorists are advised that there will be lane closures and lane shifts along the northbound, eastbound and westbound lanes from 6:00 AM to 5:00 PM. The traffic signals will not be operational during construction. Access to 76/Circle K Gas Station from Route 10 will remain open during this time.

Motorists should proceed with caution and observe all posted speed limit and construction signs. Alternative routes and/or adjusting drive times when feasible are encouraged.

## SPECIAL ADVISORY: New Flashing Yellow Arrow at Route 8/Canada-Toto Loop Road Intersection In Barrigada (11/21/2019)

### DPW to Activate New Flashing Yellow Arrow In Barrigada

The Department of Public Works in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), plans to activate a Flashing Yellow Arrow Traffic Signal at the Route 8/Canada-Toto Loop Road Intersection in Barrigada on Tuesday, November 26.

This traffic signal will allow motorists to turn left after yielding to oncoming traffic. The Flashing Yellow Arrow is designed to help prevent vehicular accidents, move more traffic through intersections and provide additional traffic management flexibility. Motorists are advised to proceed with caution through this area.

**FLASHING YELLOW ARROW**

The Department of Public Works in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration will implement a Flashing Yellow Arrow Traffic Signal. This allows motorists to turn left after yielding to oncoming traffic.

In a national study conducted for the Federal Highway Administration, it was determined Flashing Yellow Arrows help prevent vehicular accidents, move more traffic through intersections and provide additional traffic management flexibility.

**STEADY RED**  
 STOP and wait.

**SOLID YELLOW**  
 Slow down. Prepare to STOP.

**FLASHING YELLOW**  
 You are allowed to turn left when traffic is clear. You **MUST** yield to oncoming traffic and pedestrians.

**SOLID GREEN**  
 Proceed with left turn. You have the right of way.

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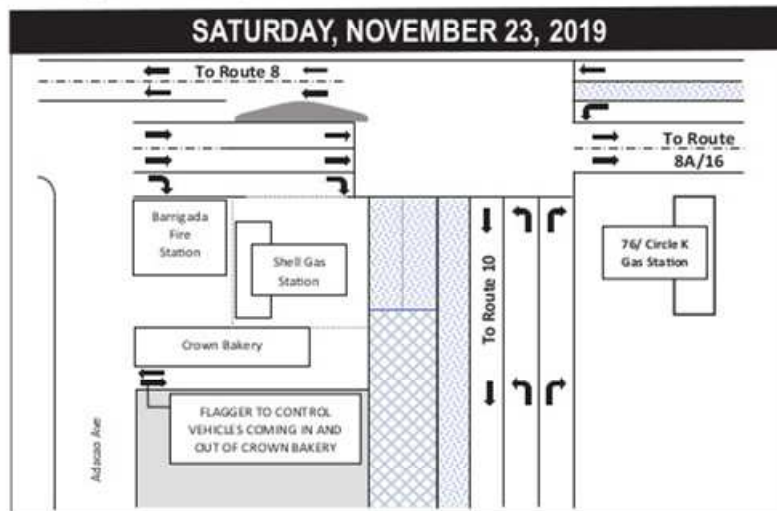

## Public Notice – Temporary Lane Closures at Route 8/10/16 Intersection in Barrigada (11/22/2019)

### PUBLIC NOTICE - TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURES

The Department of Public Works' contractor will complete the final phase of milling and paving at the Route 8/10/16 Intersection in Barrigada on Saturday, November 23, 2019. **Access to Crown Bakery and Shell Gas Station via Route 10 will be closed. Access Crown Bakery from Route 10 via Adacao Avenue, and access Shell Gas Station via Route 8.** On Sunday, November 24, 2019, the contractor will be installing permanent pavement markings along the westbound outer lane from Route 16 to Route 8. There will be lane closures and lane shifts in the area from 6:00 AM to 5:00 PM and the traffic signals will not be operational during these days. Motorists are advised to drive cautiously through the construction zones, observe all posted speed limit and construction signs. Dates are subject to change, weather permitting. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we make improvement to the roads in this intersection.

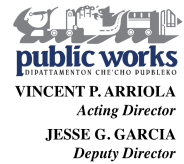

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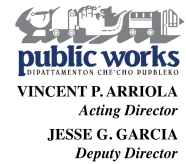

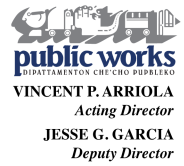
#### NOTES:

1. Sealed bids should be submitted in duplicate at the 2nd Floor, Division of Highways Building Room 201, Department of Public Works, 542 North Marine Corps Drive, Tamuning, Guam 96913, no later than 2:00 P.M., on January 17, 2020. At this time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud to the public.
2. Contract time is per the calendar days (100 days) after the issuance of Notice to Proceed (anticipated March 7, 2020). All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of 15% of the total bid amount. Accepted form of bid security may be bid bond, certified check or cashier's check payable to the Treasurer of Guam.
3. The sureties of all bonds must be on the approved listing by the Government of Guam or United States Department of Treasury list as "Companies Holding Certificates of Authority as Acceptable Sureties on Federal Bonds and Acceptable Reassuring Companies". The penal amount of the bond shall not exceed the surety's underwriting limit as stated in the Department of Treasury listing. A notarized true copy of Certificate of Authority is also required.
